- November 15/April 15: Completed enhanced slide show or voice thread of about 15 minutes submitted to mentor with sample homework or class questions; completed unit submitted to Graduate Coordinator for approval by Graduate Committee (unit consists of essay, slide show or voice thread, and sample homework or class questions). Student presents enhanced slide show or voice thread presentation at department forum (5-minute introduction and 10-minute segment).
