

Crime: Things we see at USA



- ✓ Theft of Personal Items: Phones, laptops, tablets, textbooks, and other valuables—often left in unlocked vehicles or unattended areas.
- ✓ Unattended Property: Items left in locations such as the Library, Rec Center, Classrooms, or Dining Hall are frequent targets.
- **✓ Reminder:** Always lock your car and secure your room.
- ✓ Drug & Alcohol Involvement: Frequently a contributing factor in crimes involving individuals.
- ✓ Traffic Safety Concerns: Distracted pedestrians and drivers are a leading cause of traffic-related incidents on campus.

Parking Services: The Essentials

- ALL vehicles parked on campus MUST have a valid/current Parking Permit Displayed
- For students, tuition and fees include parking privilege; however, still must register vehicle & order permit online



Parking Services: The Essentials

- The multi-zone parking system at South was implemented to ease congestion and improve safety.
- Previously, open parking led to gridlock, spot hunting, and hazards for pedestrians and cyclists.
- Parking Zones distribute parking more evenly among students, faculty, and staff.
- The system ensures each group has access to designated lots based on their needs.



Students Cannot drive to class

- While convenient parking at every stop is ideal, it's not practical or sustainable.
- Once parked in your designated zone, consider these option:
 - Walking: Most academic buildings are within a 10-15 minute walk.
 - Biking: Bike racks are available near most buildings.
 - JagTran Shuttle: Free shuttle service with stops across campus.
- This multimodal approach enhances safety, eases congestion, and supports sustainability
